Entry Eligibility	All Swimmers must be fully registered as a Competitive Swimmer (on Swim Central) to nominate for these Sprint Championships. 'Recreational' swimmers entries are ineligible. Qualifying Times Qualifying times must have been achieved after January 1st 2021 at an approved qualifying meet. Club night, club championships are NOT ACCEPTABLE, no times (NT) are only acceptable for MC and 8-9yr old swimmers.
