2023 Angel Bay Team Cup

You are invited to attend the 2023 Angel Bay Team Cup

Date	Saturday 21 st January 2023
Time	7:00am warm-up for 8:00am start
Nomination fee	<p>\$7.50 per individual event and associated Swim Central fees (includes digital program).</p> <p>No cost for the relay event. Clubs will be able to nominate their relay team on the day of the event.</p> <p>An official levy of \$2 per swimmer will be charged upon entry in Swim Central – this will be passed through to SGC technical officials.</p>
Venue	<p>Trinity Lutheran College – 641 Ashmore Rd, Ashmore (Ashmore Rd Campus)</p> <p>10 Lane – 25m Heated (27 deg) Swimming Pool complex</p>
Gate entry	<p>Free entry for spectators, competitors and coaches</p> <p>Swimming Gold Coast encourages people considered high risk (aged 70+, have pre-existing medical or auto-immune conditions etc.) not to attend the swim meet.</p>
Divisions	<p>Clubs will compete in 2 divisions: large clubs and small clubs. Large clubs will have more than 45 competitive swimming members aged between 6 and 12 and small clubs have 45 or less competitive swimming members as at 1st January 2023.</p>
Results	<p>1st, 2nd and 3rd placings will be determined from the OFFICIAL TIMES swam in the heats. Points will be allocated to each swimmer's club for each event. Points will be allocated:</p> <p>1st: 5 points 2nd: 4 points 3rd: 3 points</p> <p>Finisher: All swimmers completing an event will receive 1 point</p> <p>Due to rule tolerances, all competitors in 25m events will only receive 1 point.</p> <p>Double points will be allocated for relays.</p>

Prizemoney	<p>The clubs with the most points in each of the 2 divisions (large and small clubs) will receive the following prizemoney:</p> <p>1st place: \$600 2nd place: \$400 3rd place: \$200</p> <p>This prizemoney will be paid directly to the clubs and not to any individual. Trinity Aquatic will not be eligible to win any prizemoney but may win the trophy. Prizemoney is subject to change depending on entry numbers.</p>
Ribbons	<p>For the 50m & 100m events, ribbons will be awarded in age groups applicable to that event (8, 9, 10, 11, 12 yrs)</p> <p>For the 200m events, ribbons will be awarded in age group applicable to that event (9, 10, 11 and 12y)</p> <p>Points will be allocated to your club.</p> <p>Medals will not be awarded in any events (only Ribbons).</p> <p>Age Champions will not be recognised.</p>
Nominations close	<p>Friday 13th January 2023 at 11:59pm</p> <p>Nominations may close earlier should the cap (5 hours) be reached.</p> <p>All entries must be submitted through swim central</p> <p>No manual entries will be accepted, except approved visiting swimmers, as below.</p>
Late entries	<p>Late entries WILL NOT be accepted, under any circumstances.</p>
Age Requirements	<p>Age as of 21st January 2023.</p> <p>6yrs is the minimum age and 12yrs is the maximum age for this meet.</p>
Status	<p>This is a Swimming Queensland and Swimming Gold Coast sanctioned Qualifying meet.</p>
Code of conduct	<p>By entering this swim meet all swimmers and attendees agree to adhere to the Swimming Gold Coast code of conduct. The code of conduct can be found at the following link. CODE OF CONDUCT LINK</p>
Entry Eligibility	<p>All Swimmers must be fully registered as a Competitive Swimmer on Swim Central to nominate for 2023 Team Cup.</p> <p>'Recreational' swimmers are ineligible to enter.</p> <p>No qualifying times required for this meet.</p>

<p>Visiting swimmers</p>	<p>Swimmers registered to Gold Coast Clubs that are members of another Federation, or from Interstate, are permitted to swim.</p> <p>A member of another Federation must be shown in the program with a (V) beside their first name and the Federation they are registered with.</p> <p>Inter-State swimmers (not members of another Federation) must be shown in the program with a (V) beside their surname and the club they are registered with.</p> <p>Swimmers must be registered in SAL Swim Central and be able to enter via the online entry form.</p> <p>There will be no manual entries accepted.</p>
<p>Entry Cap</p>	<p>Swimmers are only able to enter a maximum of 6 events at this meet.</p>
<p>Events</p>	<p>As per the attached Program of Events.</p> <p>This meet to be conducted as timed finals. Swimmers will compete within their individual age groups. Trinity Aquatic, in consultation with the chief referee, also reserves the right, on the day, to combine heats and / or events. If less than 3 nominations are received for an event, Trinity Aquatic reserves the right to cancel the event and refund nominations.</p>
<p>Withdrawals / Refunds</p>	<p>Any withdrawals requested prior to the closing of nominations will be fully refunded through Swim Central. After nominations have closed, no refunds will be processed.</p>
<p>Rules</p>	<p>This meet will be conducted under the rules as documented within: "Swimming Queensland General Rules", "Swimming Queensland Championship By-Laws", "FINA" and "Swimming Australia Limited" rules.</p> <p>Competitors in the first two events should be behind the blocks in the self-marshalling zone (holding area) prior to the scheduled starting time of the session. In addition, all competitors should be in the self-marshalling zone (holding area) 4 heats prior to their own heat for events up to 200m.</p>
<p>Technical Officials</p>	<p>All technical officials will be contacted to register their availability by Chief Referee, Sharon Wicking.</p> <p>Any persons interested in learning about the possibilities of becoming a Technical Official, please make contact with the Swimming Gold Coast Chief Referee Sharon Wicking at: chiefreferee@swimminggoldcoast.org.au for communication on the opportunities available and any training requirements.</p>

Further Communication	In the week preceding the meet, further relevant information will be provided to all participants and attendees within the program. This will include facility maps, seating map and any further information as required.
Marshalling	All swim meets within the Gold Coast region are self-marshalling.
Meet Mobile	<p>Results will be published throughout this meet to the Meet Mobile application. Please note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Results published via Meet Mobile ARE NOT OFFICIAL and should be used as a guide only. • Official meet results are printed by officials during the meet and posted in a prominent position. <p>Official results are published within 48hrs of the completion of a meet on the Swimming Gold Coast website and Swim Central.</p>
Collection of Ribbons	Collection of ribbons is the responsibility of each swimmer. Ribbons not collected by the end of the meet will not be redeemed.
Timekeepers	Timekeepers will be required to be provided by each club. A timekeeping schedule will be provided at a ratio dependent on the number of swimmers attending.
Photography & images	In nominating for this meet, swimmers agree that they may be photographed by Swimming Queensland and/or Swimming Gold Coast approved photographers. Any images may be displayed for viewing and purchasing on site during the Meet and on the photographer's secure website after the Meet. They may also be used by Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast and affiliated clubs at their discretion.
Warmup	<p>Warmup will commence as follows:</p> <p>Saturday: 7:00am</p> <p>Dive starts and pacework will be allocated for Lanes 1 and 10.</p>
Food	Trinity Aquatic will be operating a BBQ. Cold drinks, coffee, tea and snacks will also be on sale.
Force Majeure	In the case of force majeure preventing or resulting in the 2023 Team Cup being cancelled, refund of registration fees will be at the discretion of Trinity Aquatic.



Competitive Dive Policy	All swimming competitors and/or their parents, accept that, by nominating for this event, that they have read and understand Swimming Australia's "Dive Entry for Competitive Swimming Policy" and the swimmer(s) meet the dive competency levels outlined in that policy.
