	Session 1 – 7.30am warm-up for 8.30am start Session 2 – 8.00am warm-up for 9.00am start					
Time	Lanes will be available in the alternate side of the separating bulkhead of the 50m training pool (competition pool for this meet) for additional warmup / cooldown facilities. Dive pool or the 50m competition pool are not available.					
	Dive starts and pacework will be allocated for Lanes 0 and 9.					
	Gold Coast Aquatic Centre Marine Parade, Southport					
Venue & Gate entry	Spectators will be permitted access to the venue during the duration of the meet. Gate entry opens at 7.00am for spectators at a cost of \$3.30 per person (current at the time of writing).					
	All coaches, technical officials, volunteers & team managers will have their entry subsidised by Swimming Gold Coast.					
Spectator Attendance	Spectators are allowed in attendance; however, they will be placed on the top deck viewing area, whilst swimmers, coaches, technical officials, and team managers will be on the pool deck.					
	We are aiming to encourage club pride, team spirit and enhance the atmosphere of the Championships by placing swimmers together with their clubmates and friends on the day, whilst parents and spectators can cheer on from a better vantage point.					
Nomination fee	\$12.00 per event individual event + associated fees. Unfortunately the cost of the venue has risen substantially over the last few years and we disappointingly have to raise the cost of the Championship meets to cover this increase in addition to medal increases and other incidental costs.					
	\$2.00 swimmer surcharge to cover the cost of officials.					
Refunds	Refunds are available through Swim Central only up until the closing of entries at Friday 12 th July 2024 @ 11.59pm. Any requests for refunds after this time MUST be made in writing to president@swimminggoldcoast.org.au , be accompanied with a valid medical certificate and submitted prior to midday Monday 22 nd July 2024.

	Close: Saturday 13 th July 2024 @ 11.59pm.					
Nominations	All entries must be submitted through swim central					
	#No manual entries will be accepted, except approved visiting swimmers, as below#					
Late entries	Late entries WILL be accepted, until 6.00pm Wednesday 17 th July 2024. These are to be done through the SGC Race Secretary and will require a \$50 per swimmer late entry fee.					
Age Requirements	Age as of 20 th July 2024.					
Age nequirements	8yrs is the minimum age for these championships.					



Status	This is a Swimming Queensland and Swimming Gold Coast sanctioned Qualifying Meet.					
Marshalling	All swim meets within the Gold Coast region are self-marshalling.					
Entry Eligibility	All Swimmers must be fully registered as a Competitive Swimmer on Swim Central to nominate for this 2024 SGC SC Championships. 'Recreational' swimmers are ineligible to enter.					
	Qualifying times must have been achieved after January 1 st 2023 at an approved qualifying meet. Club night, club championships and no times (NT) are NOT ACCEPTABLE .					
	Entries will not be accepted unless the qualifying times, where applicable, have been swum and approved at a sanctioned Short Course or Long Course Qualifying Meet prior to this Championships' closing date.					
	Long Course converted times can be used, however, these will only be used where an existing short course qualifying time has not been achieved.					
	Multi-Class Swimmers must be registered as 'competitive' swimmers with a Gold Coast club. Your classification number/s must be registered against your swimmers record in Swim Central.					
Multi-Class events	All multi-class events will be conducted as Open events. There are no qualifying times for all MC events. Minimum age is 10ys+ for Multi-Class events.					
	# Please note - Multi-Class swimmers without a registered classification will be allowed to swim as an Exhibition only.					
	This Championship Meet is a closed meet, restricted for members that are registered with Gold Coast Swimming Clubs ONLY.					
Visiting swimmers	International / Interstate Swimmers that are training at pools / clubs located throughout the Gold Coast and/or international touring squads will be provided with an exemption to swim at this event, upon request. All swimming members of another federation must enter manually through the SGC Race Secretary. Training confirmation for international swimmers based on the Gold Coast must be provided by the coach. All international or interstate swimmers will be denoted as visitors and ineligible for medals.					
	In addition, an open invitation exists for swimmers that are members of Swimming North Coast (NSW) to enter, however, they will be denoted as visitors and ineligible for medals.					
	Swimmers registered with Swimming Gold Coast should compete at this 2024 SGC SC Championship event to be eligible to gain points for our Annual Awards. More information about these awards is available on our website –

Awards	Swimmers with Swimming Queensland or Swimming Australia commitments will be given special exemption if unable to attend.					
	Points will be allocated in accordance with the Swimming Gold Coast Awards Criteria.					



Timekeepers & Volunteers	Timekeepers and volunteers will be required to be provided by each club, where available. A schedule will be provided to the clubs by the region, with all volunteers, timekeeper's and the chief timekeeper to be allocated to clubs by the SGC management committee.				
Meet Mobile	 as a guide only. Official meet results are printed by officials during all meets and posted in a prominent position. Official results are published within 48hrs of the completion of a meet on the Swimming Gold Coast website event pages and Swim Central. 				
	Results will be published throughout this meet to the Meet Mobile application. Please note: Results published via Meet Mobile ARE NOT OFFICIAL and should be used				
Backstroke Ledges	Backstroke ledges will be used at this Championship meet for ages 12yrs & over.				
	Queries regarding any disqualification MUST be made by a club coach or club official only. Technical officials will not be made available to any parents / spectators regarding swimmer disqualification.				
Rules	Swimmers competing in the 800m and 1500m Freestyle events MUST provide details of their lap counter whilst checking in at the help desk. Swimmers will not be able to check-in without confirmation of an organised lap counter.				
	All events of 400m and over (400m IM, 400m Free, 800m Free and 1500m Free) require swimmers (or their Coach / Team Manager) to confirm their intention to swim at the Help Desk a minimum of one hour prior to the published start time of the relevant event. Failure to confirm their intention to swim may be taken as a withdrawal. Confirmed swimmers should then follow the self-marshalling procedures.				
	Competitors in the first two events should be behind the blocks in the self-marshalling zone (holding area) prior to the scheduled starting time of the session. In addition, all competitors should be in the self-marshalling zone (holding area) 4 heats prior to their own heat for events up to 200m and 2 heats for 400m and over events.				
	These championships will be conducted under the rules as documented within: "Swimming Queensland General Rules", "Swimming Queensland Championship By-Laws", "FINA" and "Swimming Australia Limited" rules.				
Events	These Championships are to be conducted as timed finals. If less than 3 nominations are received for an event, Swimming Gold Coast reserves the right to cancel the event and refund nominations. Swimming Gold Coast also reserves the right, on the day, to combine heats and / or events. Qualifying times for all events will be enforced.

	Swimming Gold Coast Club point score will be in place.					
	Age Champions will be recognised and awarded to each age group from 8yrs to 16yrs & over, with ages 8 & 9 awarded on Saturday 20 th July, whilst all other ages will be awarded on Sunday 21 st July at the conclusion of the meet. A minimum of 3 events in an age group must be swum to be eligible. An individual point score for all placings will be used for these championships and age champions will be determined using each swimmers' best 8 results. All individual swimmers, who swim in an event, will accrue a minimum of 1 point for their club.					
	1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd placings will be determined from the OFFICIAL TIMES swam in all Timed Finals. Medals will only be awarded to placegetters within the qualifying time. Medals will be awarded to ages 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 & Over in all 50m					
Results	events and 100m Individual Medley.					
	Medals will be awarded to ages 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 & Over age groups in the remaining 100m events, where applicable.					
	Medals will be awarded to ages 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 & Over age groups in all 200m, 400m Freestyle events.					
	Medals will be awarded to ages 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 & Over age groups in the 400m IM & 800m Freestyle events.					
	Medals will be awarded to ages 12-13, 14, 15, 16 & Over age groups in all 200m form stroke events.					
	Medals will be awarded to ages 13, 14, 15, 16 & Over age groups in all 1500m Freestyle.					
	For Multi-Class swimmers, medals/points will be awarded for 1 st , 2 nd & 3 rd place in the Open events, using the Swimming Australia Multi-Class Points System.					
Collection of medals	Collection of medals is the responsibility of each swimmer. Medals and/or awards not collected by the end of the meet will not be redeemed, nor available for delivery.					
	The following volunteer roles will be allocated to clubs on Monday 15 th July 2024 after the closing of nominations. Please register your interest with your club.					
	 Timekeepers (2 per lane per day) – Allocated on a per session basis Chief Timekeepers (1 per day) – Allocated on a per session basis Medal Presenters (2 each day) – Allocated on a per session basis Catering Distributors (2 each day) – Allocated on a per session basis Results Runners (1 each day) – Allocated on a per session basis 					
	Further opportunities for parents to assist at the Championships involve helping their clubs as a team manager. The role of the team manager is:					
VOLUNTEERS	 Supervising all swimmers from the club, especially those 17yrs & under. Monitoring the COVID responsibilities of your club at the meet. Supporting the coach(es) in matters relating to the swimmers. Ensuring swimmers know what, when and where for seating, warm-up, self-marshalling, racing and warm-down and being present for these. Being a point of contact for drop-off of swimmers. Ensuring ALL swimmers are collected and marked off upon exit from the facility. Have relevant emergency contact details for each swimmer. Commit to the time required to fulfil the role All team managers MUST have a valid working with children blue card – link here. 					



Photography & images	In nominating for this meet, swimmers agree that they may be photographed by Swimming Gold Coast approved photographers. Any images may be displayed for viewing and purchasing on site during the Meet and on the photographer's secure website after the Meet. They may also be used by Swimming Australia, Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast and affiliated clubs at their discretion.					
Merchandising	Swimming Gold Coast have partnered with Team Elite to offer some event merchandising. Once finalised, the information will be added.					
Food	A BBQ will be available throughout the meet. A detailed menu will be provided on the last page of the meet program, when available. Also, Café Catalina will be open to swimmers and spectators throughout the day.
